**STATE REGULATION OF HEALTH CARE REFORMING  
IN UKRAINE: THE ANALYSIS OF THE EXPECTED RESULTS  
OF REFORMS IMPLEMENTATION**

The expected results of reforms implementation of the health care system on the base of main theoretical fundamentals of the pilot project on the health care field reforming in Ukraine are analyzed. The existing level of the public administration of the health care system of Ukraine is clarified; it is inadequate to the new conditions and requires the formation of a qualitatively new system of management. The defects in the organization of the initial health care led to the compensatory disproportional development of such more expensive kinds of the medical care as a specialized, permanent, urgent aid. The disproportion in the development of outpatient and inpatient medical care is one of the main reasons that cause reorganization of the health care system on the basis of priority development of IHC. Taking into consideration the limited opportunities of the Ukrainian state in the period of economic reforms, an extremely pressing issue is the search for new forms of the state regulation that would bring significant off-budget funds to the health care reform process. In our opinion, the best way of solving this problem is widespread implementation of public-private partnership in the field of health care of Ukraine.
