PRIORITY DIRECTIONS OF THE STATE POLICY
OF PUBLIC HEALTH CARE OF UKRAINE

Today Ukraine confidently holds the chosen strategic course of the proceedings and the transformation of economic reforms, aimed at strengthening its internationally as a modern democratic, social and legal state. Formation of sustainable development, which came into force on 1 January 2016 for all states - members of the United Nations, was a new challenge to identify reform priorities in health Ukraine, as each of these objectives directly or indirectly linked to individual or public health. National Strategy for institutional and structural reforms in the health sector – a targeted and controlled process, which resulted in the creation of the health care system, which will arrange medical care every citizen the right time and the right place, in sufficient quantity and with minimal costs. To reform the health sector has chosen interdisciplinary approach of defining the goals of health in all government policies. Priority routes healthcare reform in Ukraine, the following: the creation of conditions for health care reform; determine the amount of guaranteed medical assistance; providing paid medical services in the health sector; improving the system of health care financing; legislative regulation the introduction of compulsory state social health insurance; improve the provision of public of medicinal products and medical devices; improve the system disease prevention; improve the system of control over the quality of care; improving personnel policies in the health sector; ensuring the development of public-private partnerships in the health sector; community involvement and academic processes of health care reform and more.
