NONADITIVENESS OF THE SYSTEMOGENESIS OF THE PROFESSIONAL ACTIVITIES OF PUBLIC SERVANTS

The article reveals signs of non-additivity of the systemogenesis of professional activities of public servants. The development of the concept of systemogenesis of the professional activities of public servants requires the study of a number of topical issues in the theoretical and methodological plane, as well as in terms of their implementation in the sphere of professional activity of public servants. In this context, the study of the professional activities of civil servants is proposed to be considered as a systemic education. In the process of studying the system of professional activity of civil servants, properties were discovered that indicate a number of specific manifestations, one of which can be summarized as additivity. It should be noted that the problem of nonadditivism in the professional activities of civil servants requires theoretical understanding and methodological developments in order to use them in the practice of increasing the efficiency of professional activities of civil servants. In particular, the study analyzed the manifestations of nonadditivism in the functional competence, organizational, legal and psychological subsystems of the activities of public servants. The essence of the nonadditivity of the system genesis of the professional activities of civil servants is disclosed and the generalization of the features of nonadditiveness in the system of professional activities of public servants is carried out.
